What are people searching?

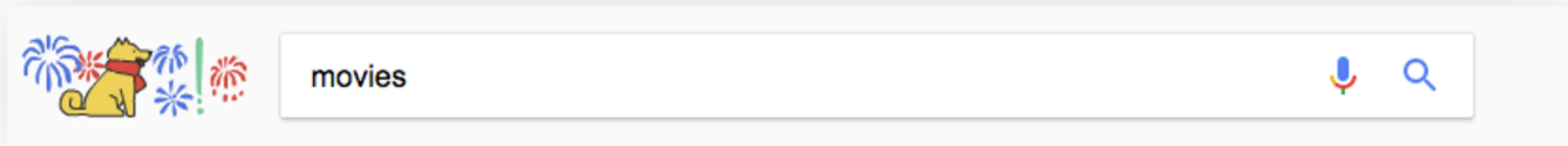
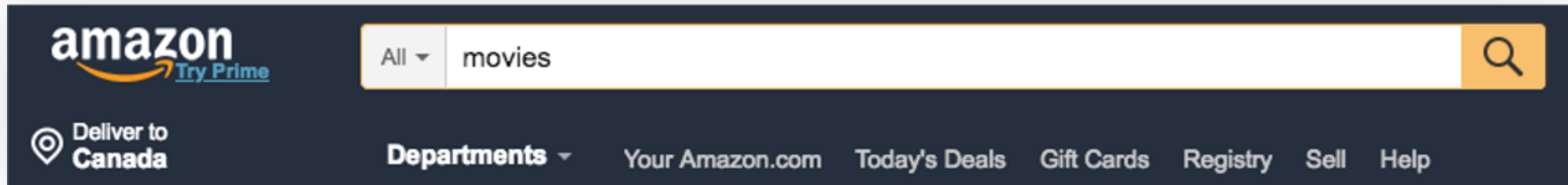
- Patrons keyword search terms like **books**, **movies**, and **DVDs**
- Patrons use keyword search more than dropdowns or advanced search
- Patrons use search to find exact matches **and** browse
- Search is the **first** place patrons go on a library website



Search

We already know how to search

- Patrons learn searching from Google, Facebook, Amazon, etc.
- They shouldn't have to learn separate search to use their public library

Tips & Tricks

- Keyword Search is will get you accurate results for the majority of author and title searches
- Use filters to drill down rather than default to collections - it's easier for patrons to edit
- Use Active Filters for repeated searches with the same attributes
- Save searches that have reuse value
- Share search permalinks with patrons


Creating Lists

Flagging Inappropriate Comments

Flagging Content

- Offensive content must be flagged three times to be tagged as such
 - Happens rarely, explain why it is offensive to you or your community
- Spoilers must be flagged twice to be tagged as such
 - Usually on children's titles, no explanation needed
- Violates Appropriate Use Standards – this content must specifically violate the appropriate use standards as documented
 - Three flags will send it to our privacy officer, who reviews it
 - Under first amendment, we must give American users the ability to edit their content
 - If it's still offensive, we are able to delete it


