# **Project Updates**

The project to install 33 new routers at OWLSnet member libraries is running ahead of schedule, with more than half of the new routers in place.

The project to move OWLSnet email services from a local server to Office 365 is underway. Waupaca is serving as a test site. We hope to roll out the new service to all libraries in the fall.

#### **Library News**

Iola Public Library announced that they will be increasing their library by 2,900 square feet with hopes of a November 2017 ground break.

Keri Rose at Hortonville Public Library and Rebecca Hoffman at Marion Public Library, WI were selected to participate in the 2017 Wisconsin Youth Services Development Institute. The institute provides professional development and networking for Wisconsin public library staff who serve babies, children, and teens in smaller public libraries.

Kristi Pennebecker of Weyauwega Public Library received exciting news that the WPLC User / Non-User Survey Workgroup accepted her research project proposal. Weyauwega will receive private and free consultations with Morrill Solutions Research to refine and implement their survey to investigate building renovation or expansion and to analyze their results.
